Dr Marko Kadija is one of the pioneers of arthroscopic surgery in the region. The transformation of arthroscopy from diagnostic into surgical procedure was principle, which led to quick implementation of all arthroscopic surgical intervention in knee in every day practice at Clinic of Ortopaedic Surgery and Traumatology, Clinical Center of Serbia. Operating technique improvement, as well as following new trends in ligament reconstruction, meniscus and cartilage, has continue to be of interest together with education of young surgeons, who perform independently high number of knee arthroscopy. Knee surgery also implies arthroplasty implementation. At the Clinic, knee prothesis surgery includes: primary, total and unicondilar prothesis and arthroplasty revisions. Besides arthroscopic and arthroplastic procedures, Dr Kadija is specialized in orthopaedic traumatology, especially knee, as well as periprosthetic fractures, complex demanding injuries and hemophilic arthropathy patients.
